

U.K. MODERN SLAVERY ACT STATEMENT

Inspire Medical Systems, Inc. ("Inspire") is a medical technology company focused on the development and commercialization of innovative, minimally invasive solutions for patients with obstructive sleep apnea.

This Modern Slavery Act Statement (this "Statement") of Inspire for the year ended December 31, 2024, is made in accordance with the United Kingdom Modern Slavery Act 2015 (the "Act") and on behalf of Inspire and its subsidiaries. The Act requires us to set forth the steps we have taken to ensure modern slavery, as such term is defined in the Act, is not taking place in our business or supply chains.

Inspire is committed to conducting business in accordance with the highest ethical standards and applicable laws. We maintain, and all of our employees are expected to adhere to, our Code of Business Conduct and Ethics ("Code of Conduct"), which serves as the foundation of our company's culture. All Inspire employees must complete training on our Code of Conduct and certify that they understand and will comply with the expectations contained in our Code of Conduct on an annual basis. We also maintain an anonymous hotline for employees to report concerns regarding violations of the Code of Conduct.

Additionally, Inspire employees are expected to comply with our Human Rights Policy, which reflects our commitment to respecting human rights wherever we operate. Under the policy, the use of child labor or any form of forced or compulsory labor, including modern slavery and human trafficking, in any aspect of our business and operations is strictly prohibited.

Inspire's suppliers are expected to comply with our Supplier Code of Conduct (the "Supplier Code"), which prohibits our suppliers from the use of child labor or any form of forced or compulsory labor, including modern slavery and human trafficking, in any aspect of their business, operations or supply chain. We expect our suppliers to have systems and processes to ensure compliance with these expectations and applicable laws. We maintain the right to audit our suppliers for compliance with the expectations under our Supplier Code and provide a process for reporting known or suspected violations.
