1.0 PURPOSE

To promote transparency clearly and proactively with regards to the company's interactions with government entities and political campaigns.

2.0 SCOPE

Company-wide. This Policy applies to Delek US Holdings, Inc., its subsidiaries, its affiliates, and all employees of Delek or its subsidiaries and affiliates ("Delek" or "Company"), including Delek Logistics Partners, LP ("DKL").

3.0 DEFINITIONS

Advocacy: Arguing in favor of a cause or idea in an attempt to influence the form and implementation of public policies.

Independent Expenditure: Spending on communications that expressly advocate for the election or defeat of a clearly identified candidate that is not made in cooperation, consultation, or concert with, or at the request or suggestion of, a candidate, a candidate's authorized committee, or their agents, or a political party or its agents.

Political Action Committee: A voluntary association of persons who share political objectives and pool their resources to increase the impact of their contributions to candidates.

4.0 POLICY

Delek believes that companies can play a constructive role in the development of public policies that positively impact their industries, employees, suppliers, and customers. As such, Delek is committed to participating in the legislative and regulatory processes.

To ensure that such activities are conducted in a manner that inspires confidence in our ethics and integrity practices, Delek commits to:

- Observe applicable regulations and laws;
- Disclose corporate advocacy activities and contributions to tax exempt organizations that lobby;
- Support policies that facilitate the transition of the downstream and midstream energy industries towards a decarbonized future while simultaneously allowing for the generation of market competitive returns;
- Abstain from the use of corporate funds to directly support individual candidates for elected office or for independent expenditures;

- Publish the criteria used by our political action committee (PAC) to evaluate candidates for elected office.

This policy applies to situations where employees act on behalf of Delek US Holdings, Inc. When engaging in personal political activity on their own time and at their own cost, employees must not represent themselves as acting on behalf of the company. This includes making it clear that they are not speaking on behalf of Delek when publishing online political content.

Employees must also comply with the “Political Contributions” and “Public Communications” provisions of the Code of Business Conduct and Ethics.

5.0 RESPONSIBILITIES & AUTHORITY

5.1 The Vice President of Government Affairs, Public Affairs and Communications is responsible for producing and publishing the disclosures described above.

5.2 The Chief Compliance & Corporate Governance Counsel is responsible for facilitating the observance of applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations.

5.3 Potential or actual violations of this Policy should be reported without fear of retaliation to any of the following resources:
