- 1. Provides leadership to the Board
- 2. Provides support and advice to the CEO
- 3. Maintains the authority to call meetings of the Board of Directors and meetings of the independent Directors
 - Promotes effective communication on developments occurring between Board meetings
- 4. Presides over:
 - Meetings of the Board of Directors
 - Executive sessions of the independent Directors without management present
 - Annual and special meetings with shareholders
- 5. Briefs the CEO on issues and concerns arising in the executive sessions of the Board
- 6. Organizes the work of the Board
 - Establishes the annual schedule of the Board
 - Establishes the agendas for all Board meetings in collaboration with the CEO
 - Consults with all Directors concerning Board agendas and information provided to the Board
- 7. Helps enable access to information to help the Board to monitor the Company's performance and the performance of management
 - Facilitates communication between and among the independent directors and management
 - Oversees the distribution of information to Directors
- 8. Coordinates periodic Board input and review of management's strategic plan for the Company
- 9. Works with the Chairman of the Corporate Governance and Nominating Committee ("Governance Committee") with respect to the recruitment, selection and orientation of new Board members and committee composition
- 10. Oversees the Organization and Compensation Committee's development of appropriate objectives for the CEO and monitors performance against those objectives
- 11. Coordinates and chairs the annual Board performance review of the CEO and communicates results to the CEO
