

Green Logistics Policy

The JD Group embraces its responsibility to reduce the environmental impact of our operations, including but not limited to logistics and delivery.

Almost all areas of the provision of domestic and global logistics is via outsourced partners. We work with world-leading organisations to ensure best in class delivery – from customer and store experience to reducing the environmental impact of operations via 'Green logistics'

Green logistics aids the reduction of environmental impact relating to the movement of our products – both merchandise and non-merchandise. The largest environmental impact area of logistics is via greenhouse gases, contributing to carbon emissions.

Accessing and utilising carbon footprint data is integral to both JD and our suppliers validating our emissions figures, in accordance with the certified Science Based Targets of JD Group. As a Group, we work with leading suppliers capable of investing in, and successfully implementing 'greener' and more sustainable solutions. Our assessment criteria for logistics providers includes:

- ✓ Compliance with the JD Group Environmental Standards and Commitments, contained within our [Ethical Code of Practice](#)
- ✓ Reducing energy consumption and emissions of greenhouse gases from product collection through to final customer delivery
- ✓ Proactively offering environmentally innovative delivery solutions to online consumers, providing JD customers with choices that encourage the reduction of carbon emissions
- ✓ Improving vehicle efficiencies via fuel consumption optimisation and improved route planning
- ✓ Evidencing reviews of lower carbon transport solutions and fuel options including:
 - Gas vehicles CNG (Compressed Natural gas), LNG (Liquefied Natural Gas)
 - Green HVO (Hydrotreated Vegetable Oil) vehicles
 - Electric HGVs (Heavy Goods Vehicles) and vans
 - Hydrogen Fuel Cell Vehicles
- ✓ Demonstrating clear commitments to 'net-zero' emission targets, supported by independent, verifiable sources such as the Carbon Disclosure Project, the RE100 and Science Based Targets Initiative

Our Green Logistics policy is an agenda item for the JD Group ESG Committee and is referenced within both regulatory and voluntary disclosures made by JD Group.
